Lenten Parish Mission

Lenten Parish Mission will begin on the **Fourth Sunday of Lent**, which is the **15th of March, 2015**. The mission preacher, **Fr. Stephen Romano Almagno, OFM** who is a Franciscan priest coming from **Mount Alvernia Retreat Center** in Wappinger Falls, NY will preach about the Lenten Parish Mission at all the Masses on the weekend of 14th (Saturday evening 5:00 p.m. Mass) and 15th of March (at all the Sunday Masses). Then, the Parish Mission is going to take place in the evening at **7:00 p.m. on Sunday (15th of March), Monday (16th of March), and Tuesday (17th of March)**.

It is also good to know that **Parish Missions** began in the eighteenth century. St. Alphonsus de Liguori, the founder of the Redemptorist Order, made significant contributions to the development of parish missions. Some years later, the Redemptorists brought parish missions to America. A parish mission is a preaching event, which is centered on the Word of God and Catholic teachings on consecutive evenings. The preaching usually emphasizes a deepening of our personal relationship with God, our sense of belonging to the parish community, and our awareness of a greater service of one another in Christ. Just like a retreat, a parish mission calls us to take some time to look into our inner lives, to strengthen our relationship with God, and to experience divine healing. As we live in this rapidly changing society, sometimes, we can live with divided selves due to stress and demands. When our selves are divided, we may live with fearful thoughts, confusing feelings, imaginary anxious thoughts about the future, and so on. Then, as a result, we may find ourselves stressed out, which is a state that can create a chronic state of anxiety and a sense of 'something is always missing in life.' In order to find relief and healing, we need to step back from our worldly activities and then be with God as we are. In this way, we hope this Parish Mission can be a great means to experience the healing and the comforting presence of God in some areas of our lives. A parish mission is a time for each parishioner to renew one's personal relationship with Jesus and to experience peace and healing, revitalizing the Parish in its mission, and sustaining its community. *Fr.
